




Item 1: Order lab tests




Item 2: Order imaging tests






Item 3: Retrieve lab results directly from source

We have a full point to point interfaces with Quest, Lab Corp, Unipath, Centura and Metropath




Item 4: Retrieve imaging text reports directly from source

Through Mobile MD the reports and dictations are interfaced into the patient's EHR. The blue checkmark indicates that the document was "signed off" through the Provider Approval Queue.




<u>Item 6: Route and manage current and historical test results to</u> <u>appropriate Clinical personnel for review, filtering and comparison</u>

The provider approval queue (PAQ) directs labs, images, notes, documents and data from HIE to the primary care provider. These then need to be "Accepted" which is the same as signed off, they can be reassigned to other providers or they can be rejected altogether, sent back to our Medical records department if the patient is not our patient. The To Do button allows sending a task (such as to a nurse for follow up) right from the PAQ and attaches the document or lab for easy retrieval.
