

## PPC 5: ELECTRONIC PRESCRIBING Element C: Electronic Decision Support – Efficiency

At CHC-B, we work with many different payors and about one third of our patient's are uninsured. This situation encourages our providers to engage in cost-efficient prescribing, often sending prescriptions to multiple pharmacies to achieve the lowest cost for our patients. EHS's electronic prescription writer provides general automatic alerts for different choices including generics. This screen shot shows a list of the choices if a provider begins by prescribing "Lasix":



We are currently a BETA site for testing EHS's Extended ERx which does provide connectivity to payer-specific formularies that automatically alerts providers to alternative drugs, including generics. Here is a screen shot from that training module & a fake patient:
