Colorado: Beginning FY 2004, only Medicaid fee-for-service births are counted. Data per the Inpatient Utilization Reports created by the Colorado Foundation of Medical Care. Colorado's total births are from the U.S. Census Bureau, State Population Estimates.

Montana: The number of Births Financed by Medicaid has increased significantly since the last report for 2003. The definition of a Medicaid birth in MT is any child that had a paid Medicaid claim indicating delivery, or a paid Medicaid claim in the first month of life, or a child that has been matched to a mother eligible for Medicaid and the mother had a paid Medicaid claim indicating a delivery.
