Conference Afternoon Session #1 – Operations Track:

Pharmacy Operations, 340B Financial Sustainability & Growth

This session will dig into the best practices for monitoring and optimizing your pharmacy program. Attendees will gain insight into key pharmacy metrics, including how to measure, track, and leverage data to drive operational change. Presenters will discuss how to prepare for and estimate revenue changes resulting from Medicare Maximum Fair Price (MFP) negotiation and inflationary penalty pressures. They will also explore how the Sliding Fee Scale can help health centers improve access to affordable medications, including an update on the Bureau of Primary Health Care's (BPHC) new clarification regarding pharmacy charges. Learn from seasoned pharmacy leaders as they share proven techniques to improve pharmacy capture rates, strengthen program performance, and maintain the long-term financial sustainability of your pharmacy. This session will prepare attendees for future changes and provide both knowledge and tools to navigate what's ahead.

The 340B Policy Landscape: Risks, Opportunities & What's Next

This session will highlight current hot topics in the 340B regulatory and policy landscape, including pending legislation, relevant court cases, manufacturer actions, drug pricing changes, rebate models, evolving Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) programs (BALANCE, GLOBE, GUARD), and more. Participants will learn about regulatory and policy changes impacting the industry and eroding 340B margins.
